General aim

This Media Literacy Conference invites people from these initiatives to develop a better expertise in the approach and results of their media work and to deepen democratic and direct media impetus in Europe. The topic of "*Media and Social Intervention*" focuses on methods and examples which helped people to develop their own critical voice through the use of independent media.
