

All these methods of cutting are mostly used on seed fruit trees. If used on stone fruit trees, gum secretion could result.

- Cross-wise cuts above the bud and branch in order to increase their growth.
- 2 & 3. Cuts below the bud and branch to turn them into fruiting limbs.
- 4. Girdling and spiral removal of the bark.
- 5. Grooving cuts, (not pictured in the book) as Elena pictured it from the discription.
