- 3. Communication of a Coherent Idea

In December, 2013, the writer of the best paper submitted between the period September, 2013, and December, 2013, will be given a **Samsung Galaxy Tab 7.0 Plus.**

Because we have a limited number of editors, papers will be reviewed for publication on a first come first served basis.
