- City of Ithaca updates: City planning group hasn't met in months. New sustainability coordinator developing a comprehensive plan. CCE is expected to lose county money that will probably result in a loss of 11 positions.
- Ulysses: Krys report updates on ag plan, conservation zone, and lake shore zone. New 4 day/week planner hired. Discussion of newly developed regulations that will alter zoning regs.
