

1. Follow the Dune Drive approximately 6 miles until you see a sign indicating the direction to the Backcountry Parking Area.
2. Turn left at the intersection.
3. The first large parking area (Area 34) to your left will have a split-rail fence hitching rail. This is the parking area where horses can be unloaded. If you are parked in the area with the Backcountry Camping sign, you are in the wrong place. Please go back one area to the split-rail fence hitching rail.
4. Remember to clean up all debris (including hay, grass, alfalfa) and horse droppings from the parking area.
5. Contact a Ranger if you have questions or concerns.
